Child Safety Explore your house as a child would

and look for danger

Elderly Safety

Tour your house as an adult with reduced mobility and look for danger

General

Damage happens all the time check the interior and exterior for simple fixes

Repairs

Make sure any DIY repairs are finalized

Function

Batteries

New batteries for thermostats and remote controls (fireplace, ceiling fan, blinds, etc.)

Vacation Mode


Prep for occupancy by turning on water heaters, water supplies, and HVAC systems

Physical Access

Provide a clear path to the Attic. Crawlspace, Storage Areas, and Owner's Closet

Declutter

Remove or consolidate personal belongings

Inspection Space
